

Casco Bay YMCA Splash Party Rental Form

Reservations for a splash party must be made at least 2 weeks in advance and must be accompanied by payment and a completed application. First come first serve. Call Brian @ 865-9600 or email @ btownsend@cumberlandcountyyymca.org for availability. Enclosed is a copy of the pool rules and our swim test (non-swimmer) policy. All splash party participants should be familiar with the pool rules and swim testing policy. All splash party participants should meet on the bleachers to go over the rules with the lifeguard before entering the water. The room and kitchen are required to be cleaned-up after use and parties are expected to be ready to leave when the time is up.

- Cost for pool and room is: \$130 members; \$185 for non-members (all fees non-refundable)
- Cost for Prime Time Space in addition to pool and room rentals: \$25

Big Pool (Temperature 80°):

- Available on Saturdays from Pool 1-2 & Room 2-3 and Sundays from Pool 2-3 & Room 3-4
- Rental is for three lanes of the lap pool only
- All children must be accompanied by an adult in the water with the following ratios used:
 - 1 adult to every 2 non-swimmers (without floatation)
 - 1 adult to every 5 swimmers
- Max # of children allowed in a splash party is 25.
- Any person in the group who wishes to swim or jump in the deep end must pass a swim test administered by the lifeguard

Small Pool (Temperature 88°):

- Available on Saturday from Pool 4-5 & Room 5-6 and Sunday from Pool 11-12 & Room 12-1
- All children must be accompanied by an adult in the water with the following ratios used:
 - 1 adult to every 2 non-swimmers (without floatation)
 - 1 adult to every 5 swimmers
- Max # of children allowed in a splash party is 20.

Y Casco Bay Regional YMCA Pool Rules

Rules are under the discretion of the lifeguard on duty:

- **Children 8 and under must be accompanied in to the water at all times.**
- **All persons under the age of 18 must be swim tested before entering into deep water.**
- Showers are required by Maine State law before entering the pool.
- Those with shoulder length or longer hair must have it contained with a hair tie or cap.
- Children who are not potty trained must wear swim diaper plus rubber pants. **(2 tight fit layers)**
- Proper swim attire (no street clothes or cut offs) must be worn in to the pool.
- The lifeguard has the right to limit the number of swimmers in either pool
- All swimmers must stay off of the platform in the small pool, as it is slippery.

Health and Safety

- Both pools are handicap accessible by lift, which is to be operated by staff only.
- Street shoes are prohibited on deck to keep the dirt, debris and other biological matter at a minimum.
- No food on deck. Only bottle water in plastic containers is permitted.
- **Walk** – pool deck can be slippery
- Please remove all band aids and hair pins before entering the pools.
- People with open cuts or wounds are advised not to use the pools. Chlorine inhibits new skin growth.
- Anyone with an infectious disease is prohibited from using the pools.
- It is the responsibility of the individual with a life threatening medical condition to inform the aquatic staff before entering the pool.
- All items must be kept clear of the pool railings separating the two pools.

Diving

- Diving is permitted only in the 9 ft area of the large pool, between starting blocks
- Forward dives only.
- Keep clear of pool ladders.
- Starting blocks are to be used under the supervision of certified swim coach.

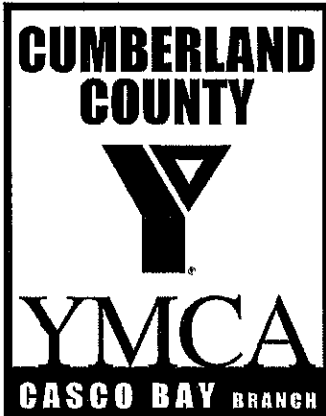
Equipment

- Bubble belts, barbells, noodles, toys may not be brought in to the YMCA pools.
- Inflatables of any kind are not permitted.
- Kickboards are for lessons and lap swim only.
- Mask and snorkels may be used by adults only.
- Flippers are to used in the main pool only.

Lap Swim

- Please be courteous of others and alert the other swimmers before joining their lane.
- Two swimmers may split a lane each taking a side. When there are three or more swimmers please circle swim in a counter clockwise direction.
- Stay off lane lines.

Swim Testing Policy (under

Any person who enters the water alone, must pass a swim test.

All "swimmers" must be marked every visit.

You must be able to float in chest deep water for 20-30 sec. and return to a standing position comfortably .

To be in water depth greater then chest deep: You must swim the length of the pool and float for 20-30 sec.
(Must retest when going from small pool to main pool)

If you can not meet either of the above (3&4), you must have an adult present in the water **and** within arms reach.

"Swimmers" 12 and under must have an adult in the building at all times.

"Swimmers" 8 and under must have an adult in the pool area at all times.

Bubble Belts and Coast Guard approved life-jackets are also available.

**"Swimmers", refers to anyone who has met the swim test requirements.*

Maximum of two (2) non-swimmers per adult, floatation required for three (3) or more, Max 5

***Although floatation is generally not required , due to programming, #'s and staffing you may be asked to use floatation during some swim times.**

**Aquatics Staff reserve the right t require floatation at any time.*
